CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Milton Keynes (Parish of Newport Pagnell) Order 1985

Made	30th July 1985
<u>Coming into Operation -</u>	
for the purposes	
described in article 2(1)	31st July 1985
for all other purposes	1st October 1985

Whereas the Milton Keynes Borough Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the borough:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make to the Secretary of State proposals concerning, inter alia, a new parish of Newport Pagnell:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals, implementing in the first instance those relating to the new parish:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milton Keynes (Parish of Newport Pagnell) Order 1985.

2. - (1) 31st July 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st October 1985.

Interpretation

3. In this order -

"the borough council" means the Milton Keynes borough council;

"borough ward" means a ward of the borough of Milton Keynes;

"the boundary map" means the map issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Milton Keynes (Parish of Newport Pagnell) Order 1985";

"the former urban district" means the urban district of Newport Pagnell; and

"the 1976 Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations mentioned in article 2(1).

Creation of new parish of Newport Pagnell

4. - (1) In Milton Keynes, there shall be created, without change to the boundary of any county electoral division, a new parish to be called Newport Pagnell, consisting of that part of the area of the former urban district shown outlined in red on the boundary map. The new parish shall form part of the Newport Pagnell borough ward.

(2) There shall be a parish council for the new parish, and the parish shall be divided into three parish wards as shown by a broken red line on the boundary map. The Central ward shall be represented by 5 parish councillors, the West ward by 4 and the Tickford ward by 3.

(3) Elections of parish councillors for the new parish shall be held on such day prior to 1st October 1985 as the returning officer shall appoint. The persons elected shall come into office on 1st October 1985, and retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1988.

(4) The proper officer of the borough council shall convene -

the annual meeting of the new parish council for 1985, which shall be held in October of that year; and

the first assembly of the parish meeting for the new parish.

If the first assembly takes place before the first annual meeting of the new council, the parish meeting may appoint a person to take the chair, who shall have, for the purposes of that occasion only, the powers and authority of a chairman.

(5) For the purposes of regulation 40 (statutory definitions of areas) of the 1976 Regulations, any reference to the area of the former urban district shall be construed as including the area of the new parish.

(6) Regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the 1976 Regulations shall apply to the area of the former urban district as if it were a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41(2). For the purposes of any provision in force to which that regulation applies, that area shall include the area of the new parish.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order creates in the borough of Milton Keynes a new parish of Newport Pagnell from part of the area of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell. The new parish comes into being on 1st October 1985.

Prints of the detailed boundary map referred to in article 3 may be inspected at the offices of the borough council, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

The new parish will have approximately an area of 737 hectares, and population of 12,600, and a rateable value of £1,465,000.

A parish council is established for the new parish.

Consequential changes are made to local government electoral areas.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in articles 2, 3 and 4, contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.

A further order to be made in 1985 will implement other proposals relating to parish boundaries in the borough.
