### The Alnwick (Parishes) Order 2008

Made . . . . . 13<sup>th</sup> June 2008

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), makes the following Order:

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Alnwick (Parishes) Order 2008.
- (2) It shall come into force—
  - (a) for the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to elections of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of election in 2009, on the day after that on which it is made;
  - (b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2009.
- (3) In this Order “maps” means the maps prepared by the Department for Communities and Local Government, marked “Maps referred to in the Alnwick (Parishes) Order 2008” and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b).

#### Alterations to Parish Areas

2. Each area shaded and designated by a letter on the maps and specified in column (1) of the Schedule to this Order by reference to that letter shall cease to be part of the parish specified in the corresponding row of column (2) and shall become part of the parish specified in the corresponding row of column (3).
3. 1st April 2009 is the Order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect (without modification) to recommendations sent to the Secretary of State for alterations to parish areas within the District of Alnwick. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the areas concerned.


Article 2 makes alterations to the areas of the parishes of Alwinton, Biddlestone, Callaly, Hepple, Netherton, Rothbury, Snitter, and Whitton and Tosson.

Article 3 specifies 1st April 2009 as the Order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make provision of general application in relation to orders such as this Order.
