LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The South Cambridgeshire District Council (Enlargement of Parish Council) Order 2013

relating to the Parish of Hauxton

*Made this 1st day of May 2013
Coming into force with article 1(2)*

South Cambridgeshire District Council ("the Council"), in accordance with Section 82(e) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review following a request by Hauxton Parish Council to increase the number of Parish Councillors to 9 and made recommendations dated the 22nd March 2012.

The Council, having consulted with the electors in the Parish of Hauxton and other interested persons, resolved to give effect to those recommendations to ensure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient having regard to the increase in electors over the next five years.

The Council, in accordance with Section 100 of the 2007 Act, has also had regard to guidance issued under that Section (f).

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 86 and 240 (10) of the 2007 Act.

1. Citation and commencement(a)

- (1) This Order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire District Council (Enlargement of Parish Council) Order 2013 relating to the Parish of Hauxton.
- (2) It shall come into force on 5th day of May 2016 being the next ordinary day of election.

2. Interpretation

In this Order -

"county" means the county of Cambridgeshire;

"district" means the district of South Cambridgeshire

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under Section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

4. Number of Parish Councillors

The number of Councillors to be elected for the Parish of Hauxton shall be 9.

5. Electoral arrangements

- (1) The election of the two additional Parish Councillors shall be held on the 5th day of May 2016 being the day of the next ordinary election.
- (2) The persons to be elected as Parish Councillors as the result of the said election shall come into office on the fourth day after the day of election and shall retire on the fourth day after the next ordinary day of election in May 2020.

6. Order date

1st May 2013 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
