As part of your consultation on East Hampshire district boundaries, you have received comments on the current situation in the settlement and parish of "Bramshott and Liphook". The three district councillors of that district ward (Cllr. Bill Moulard, Cllr. Mrs. Rebecca Standish and Cllr. Mrs. Angela Glass), which matches the existing parish boundary, would like to make the following representation. It has been discussed with and endorsed by East Hampshire District Council Cabinet members.

Historically, the combined efforts of three District Councillors, has more than adequately and successfully covered the requirements of the Parish. Each Councillor is fully briefed as well as locally well known to the residents, and residents are confident that they can approach any of the three, to address any problem or concern which they may encounter. In the absence of any District Councillor, each of the other two will assist any resident, regardless of where within the parish, they live.

The efficiency of having three District Councillors, without the division of Wards, has proved its worth over many years, and we would endorse the continuation of this collective cover for the whole of the Parish.
