The Melton (Parishes) Order 1988

Made 29th November 1988
Coming into force-
for the purpose of
article 1(2) 1st January 1989
for all other purposes 1st April 1989

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Melton Borough Council for proposals about parishes in the borough:

Citation and commencement

1.-(1) This Order may be cited as the Melton (Parishes) Order 1988.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 1st January 1989 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).

(3) For all other purposes this Order shall come into force on 1st April 1989.

Transfer between parishes

2. The part of the parish of Asfordby in the borough of Melton which is marked A1 on the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Map of the Melton (Parishes) Order 1988" and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 shall be transferred to -

- (a) the parish of Ab Kettleby;
- (b) the Ab Kettleby ward of that parish; and
- (c) the Old Dalby ward of the borough of Melton.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

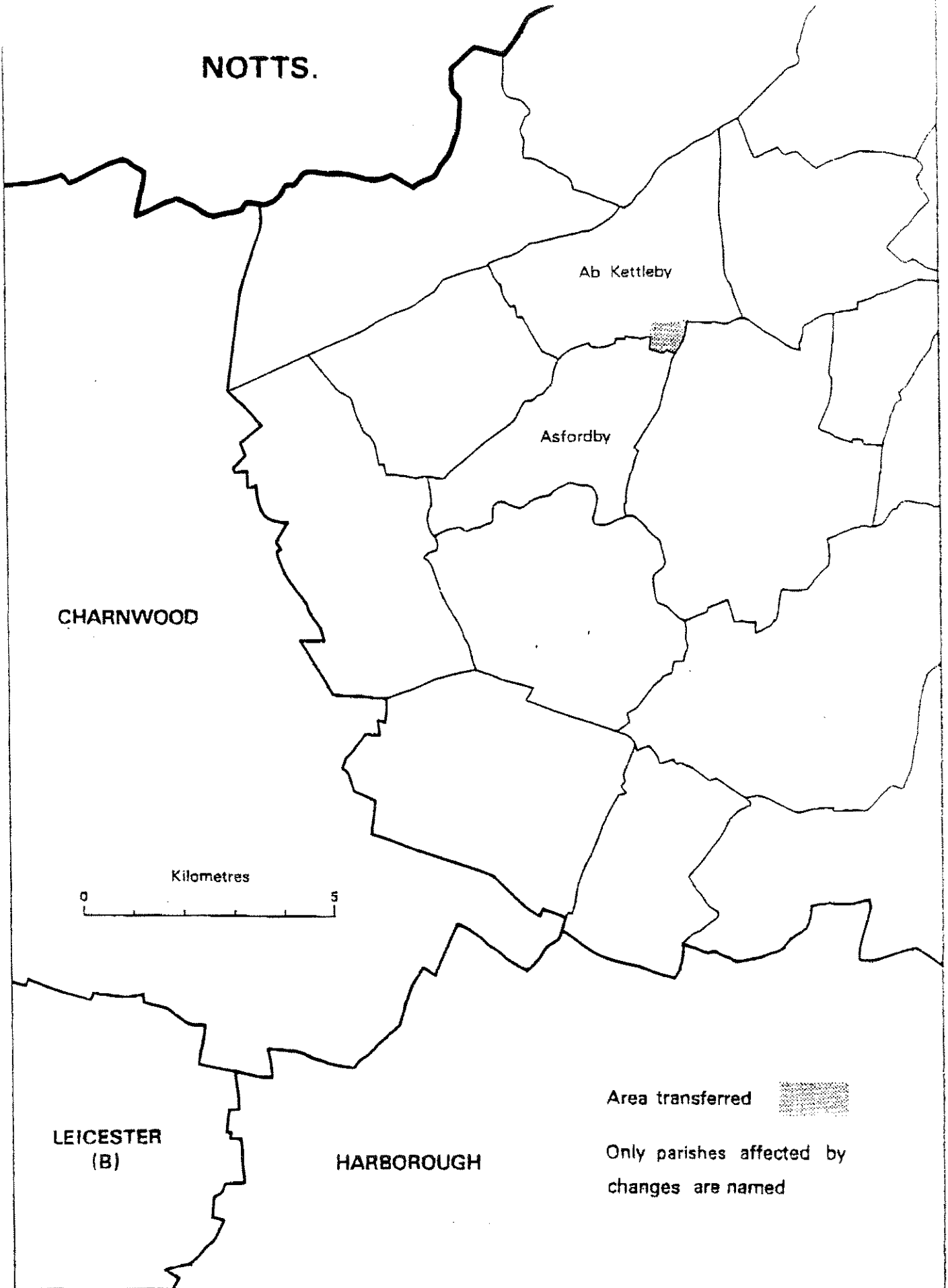
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order affects parishes in the borough of Melton by transferring an area from the parish of Asfordby to the parish of Ab Kettleby. A consequential change to local government electoral areas is made.
