The South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1984

29th November 1984

Coming into Operation -

for the purposes described in article 2(1)

1st January 1985

for all other purposes

1st April 1985

Whereas the South Cambridgeshire District Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the district:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9), and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1984.
2. -(1) 1st January 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Interpretation

3. -(1) In this order:-

"the boundary maps" means the 36 maps (duly numbered for reference) which are issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Maps of the South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1984";

"county electoral division" means "electoral division of the county of Cambridgeshire";

"the district council" means the South Cambridgeshire District Council;

"district ward" means "ward of the district of South Cambridgeshire";

"new parish" means the parish of Oakington and Westwick created by article 4(1) of this order;

"new parish council" means the parish council established by article 5(1) of this order; and

"the Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a) .

Changes in areas

4. -(1) There shall be created a new parish of Oakington and Westwick. It shall consist of the area shown outlined in red on boundary map 1, namely -

(a) the area of the parish of Oakington, except for the part marked A101;

(b) that part of the parish of Westwick marked D1;

(c) that part of the parish of Histon marked D2; and

(d) that part of the parish of Longstanton marked D3.

The new parish shall form part of the Bar Hill district ward, of the Chesterton No. 4 county electoral division, of the Cambridge petty sessional division, and of the Southern Cambridgeshire coroner's district.

(2) Other areas shall be transferred between parishes in accordance with the schedule to this order. Where a district ward is mentioned in column (5) or a county electoral division is shown in column (6), the relevant area shall also be transferred to that ward or division, as the case may be.

(3) The separate parishes of Oakington and Westwick shall cease to exist.

New parish council and meeting

5. -(1) There shall be a parish council for the new parish.

(2) From 1st April 1985 until the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1986, the new parish council shall consist of those councillors of the abolished parish of Oakington in office immediately prior to 1st April 1985.

(3) As from the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1986, the number of new parish councillors shall be 9.

(4) The annual meeting of the new parish council for 1985 shall be held in April 1985, and shall be convened by the proper officer of the district council.

(5) The first assembly of the parish meeting for the new parish shall be convened by the proper officer of the district council. If such first assembly is held before the annual meeting of the new parish council, the parish meeting may appoint a person to take the chair, and that person shall have, for the purposes of that meeting, the powers and authority of the chairman.

Expenses of new parish council

6. In the year beginning on 1st April 1985, the district council shall levy rates in the new parish and make payments to the new parish council as if the new parish council had issued a precept to the district council requiring the payment of a sum equal to the product of a rate of 2p. in the pound calculated on the total rateable value as set out in the valuation list at the beginning of that financial year.

Dissolved authorities etc.

7. The Oakington Parish Council and the parish meeting and parish trustees of Westwick shall be dissolved, and for the purposes of the Regulations, the new parish council shall be their residuary successor, assuming custody of the public books, writings and papers (including all documents directed by law to be kept therewith) of the abolished parishes.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

8. For the purposes of regulation 41(4) of the Regulations, any provision in force throughout the parishes of Oakington and Westwick shall be in force throughout the new parish.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order alters parishes in the district of South Cambridgeshire.

It:-

- (a) creates a new parish of Oakington and Westwick from parts of the parishes of Oakington, Westwick, Histon and Longstanton;
- (b) abolishes the existing separate parishes of Oakington and Westwick; and
- (c) effects other transfers of land as between parishes.

The maps forming part of this note (see pages 13 and 14) give a general guide to the areas affected as from 1st April 1985.

Prints of the detailed boundary maps, which form part of the order and are referred to in article 3, may be inspected at the offices of the district council, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library at 2 Marsham Street, London SW1.

The new parish of Oakington and Westwick will have approximately an area of 886 hectares, a population of 1,270 and a rateable value of £135,456.

The order establishes a parish council for the new parish.

Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 3, contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
