### Comment text:

I am of the belief that for Eastbourne to have twenty seven councillors, three members from nine wards makes perfect sense (with the Boundary Commission to decide whether elections are held once every four years or as at the moment, there are elections every year when one third of the seats (one per ward) are up for election. As for the boundaries I wish to propose that the wards of Old Town and Meads are merged and divided (thus still keeping to nine wards) in a new configuration. My proposed boundary would be the South Down way from the current boundary between Old Town and Ratton to the current boundary between Old Town and Meads and then the B2103 from the existing boundary between Meads and Old Town should be turned into a new boundary. This will have the effect of merging the populated side of the two wards (which I believe should be renamed Meads and Old Town) and merging the unpopulated side of the two wards which I believe should belong to next door Lewes council (as it has more in common with Lewes than Eastbourne)
