The following is the response from Dunsford Parish Council:

Dunsford Parish Council sits within the Teign Valley which is why Dunsford Parish Council reject the proposal to move the Parish to a new ward of Tedburn & Moretonhampstead.

The parishes of the Teign Valley have a long history of co-operation on many joint projects. The Parishes of Bridford Christow and Dunsford meet once a year to discuss joint issues within the Teign Valley. Projects have been jointly funded such as the skate park at Christow which is for the use of young people in the Teign Valley. Each year we co-ordinate the 'Electors Levy' to ensure any unused funds are transferred to a neighbouring parishes within the Valley. We have a long tradition of the local District Councillor co-ordinating and updating each Parish on the other Parishes activities.

Members of Dunsford Parish Council feel very strongly about the proposals and at the last meeting have threatened to resign on mass if the move goes ahead.
