Whereas the District Council of East Cambridgeshire, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the district;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 24th March 1982, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the East Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1983.

2. 1st January 1984 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—
 “the appointed day” means 1st April 1984; and

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order effects some transfers as between parishes in the District of East Cambridgeshire.

The map forming part of this note shows the areas affected.

Prints of the maps referred to in article 4 of the order may be inspected at the offices of the district council. Prints may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations referred to in article 3 of the order.

“the county” means the County of Cambridgeshire;

“the district” means the District of East Cambridgeshire; and

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1970(b).

The boundary maps

4. In this order—

“the boundary maps” means the six maps issued by the Department of the Environment in three sheets, each sheet being marked “Map sheet of the East Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1983” and with the number of the map sheet, and each map being marked with a letter; and
any reference to a map by number and letter is a reference to the map so lettered on the sheet so numbered.

Changes in areas

5. The parts of parishes described in column (1) of the Schedule to this order and marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (2) shall, in so far as parishes, electoral divisions of the county and wards of the district are specified in respect thereof in columns (3) to (5), be transferred to or form part of such areas.
