CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Melton (Parishes) Order 1992

Made - - - - 3rd. February 1992  
Coming into force -  
for the purposes referred  
to in article 1(2) - - - 20th. February 1992  
for all other purposes - - 1st. April 1992

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47 and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, following recommendations made to them by the Melton Borough Council about parishes in the borough:

Citation and commencement

- 1.- (1) This Order may be cited as the Melton (Parishes) Order 1992.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on 20th. February 1992 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (b).

(3) For all other purposes, this Order shall come into force on 1st. April 1992.

#### Transfer between parishes in the borough of Melton

- 2.- (1) In this article, "the map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Map of the Melton (Parishes) Order 1992", and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976.
- (2) The part of the parish of Somerby which is shown coloured yellow and marked "A" on the map shall be transferred to the parish of Twyford and Thorpe, to the Twyford ward of that parish, and to the Gaddesby ward of the borough of Melton.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order).

This Order affects the boundaries of two parishes in the borough of Melton. It transfers the part of the parish of Somerby lying south of Burrough Road to the parish of Twyford and Thorpe, and consequentially to the Gaddesby ward of the borough.

Prints of the map referred to in article 2(1) may be inspected at all reasonable times at the offices of the Melton District Council and at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2, Marsham Street, LONDON SW1P 3EB.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (S.I. 1976/246, amended by S.I. 1978/247) contain general provisions regarding the effect of orders such as this one.
