

Payment Notice Terms and Conditions

All customers are informed of the costs of using the M6Toll road prior to point of commitment to enter the M6Toll road. The M6Toll does accept however that despite best efforts in some cases customers may arrive at the toll plaza at the point of exit and have no means of payment.

The M6toll may offer the customer a **Payment Notice**, which will allow customers to exit the toll road, but requests that payment of the toll is made within **2 working days** of the date of the payment notice.

The amount of toll due was determined by the automatic vehicle classification system, the time of day and the toll location as applied to our current scale of charges.

If payment is not received within 2 working days MEL will commence its non-payment enforcement process and an Administration Charge of £10 will be added to the amount due. Further Charges will apply if full payment of the amount due is not received within 10 days.
