Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment

For practitioners who assess the achievement of competence in a work environment

Entry Requirements

Level 3 NVQ in Hairdressing

Duration

You are required to complete this award within 18 months of start as outlined in the Code of Practice. It is envisaged that you may well have completed this award within 12 months, if not sooner.

Cost

301 - £200 - A £100 deposit required before materials can be accessed.

302 - £200- A £100 deposit required before start of unit

Start Date

Ongoing, you may enrol throughout the year at specific time slots.

Course Details

The TAQA qualification is in two parts.

301 is assignment based which is completed alongside 302 with tutor support if required.

302 is the practical aspect of the assessment process. You will have a negotiated timetable created where you will complete this unit.

Requirements

- At least 2 learners (in salon if possible or at the training school)
- 4 assessment plans to be created with each totalling 4 hours using 3 methods of assessment. 16 hours altogether.
- You will assess these learners using the assessment plan for a total of 16 hours as per plans.
- Each session needs a reflection to be completed.
- You will be observed by your assessor, with a record held in your portfolio.
- You will be observed by an Internal Verifier and the record held in your portfolio.
- You will attend 2 standardisation meetings, records held in your portfolio.
- Records of CPD held in your portfolio.

You will shadow assessors at the training school with support from your assessor before you start assessing.

Support is given throughout by your assessor.

confidence to teach in the post 16 education sector. By the end of the course learners will understand how to set up an effective and inclusive learning environment. It is the first step towards a full teaching qualification leading to:

Course Content

Everyone on the course designs, delivers and evaluates 2 10 minute micro-teaches and a 30-minute micro teach, gaining invaluable feedback from their teacher and peers.

- Unit A looks at your roles and responsibilities as a teacher.
- Unit B involves planning your own session and the importance of providing an inclusive teaching setting that meets all individual needs.
- Unit C investigates the three main types of assessment in teaching and the pivotal role that ongoing assessment in teaching plays.
