Competition Guidelines

What you need to do

We are inviting you to Express Yourself and share with us your creative response to the following question:

How can Jersey's Our Hospital Project help to make the Island a better place?

Your response could be a poem, story, script, reflective piece, song, rap, dance, drama performance, music performance, photo/series of photos, painting, drawing, sculpture, art in nature, collage, or a combination of these. You are limited only by your imagination!

We do ask though, that you choose one of the following formats to submit your entry:



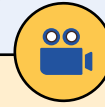
1. Typed words

- A maximum of 250 words
- A maximum of 1 file may be submitted in Word or PDF format



2. Still image(s)

- Each image may include a caption (maximum 50 words each)
- A maximum of 3 images may be submitted, up to 10Mb each in JPEG, PNG or PDF format



3. Audio-visual

- A maximum of 1 file of up to 90 seconds in length
- File size to be 50Mb or less in MPEG4 or MOV format

Judging criteria

- A panel of health professionals, industry experts and representatives from the Our Hospital Project team will evaluate the entries and select the winners.
- Entries will be assessed based on the following criteria:

Evaluation criteria	Score
1 Impact and clarity of response: How the entry responds to the competition question	40%
2 Innovation and creativity: How the entry responds to the question in a fresh and original way	30%
3 Quality and design: The overall presentation of the entry	20%
4 Adherence to the eligibility requirements	10%

- Entries will be judged in November and the winners will be announced in early December 2021.
- Decisions of the judging panel are final.



Prizes

Winning entry

- The winning entry will receive a **total prize valued at £500, including a £250 IQ Store gift-card and a £250 cash donation to a local charity of your choice** (this could be your school's PTA, or a member organisation of the Association of Jersey Charities)
- The winning entry will be **featured in future OHP newsletters and posters.**
- The winner will be offered the **opportunity to be a youth representative on the project and input into the OHP Youth Charter and other important strategies.**
- The **certificate of participation** and if a winner, the role of OHP youth representative would be a great addition to your CV or further education applications!

All entries

- **All entries will be acknowledged with an Our Hospital Project certificate and entered in a draw to WIN a £100 prize** (£50 IQ Store gift-card and £50 cash donation to your local charity of choice).

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY

- Competition entries must be uploaded via the web form which can be accessed from the Online Community Hub at ourhospital.je/community
- You will need a google account in order to complete the form and upload your work
- All entries must be uploaded by 12 noon on Wednesday 10 November 2021
- You will be asked to nominate your preferred Jersey-based organisation upon submission to receive the cash donation should you win

Competition terms

Competition entry form and conditions of entry

- You will be required to submit your entry via the web form, which can be accessed at ourhospital.je/community
- Please ensure that you have read and understood the conditions of entry before you click submit. Full terms of entry are set out in the web form.

Entry eligibility

The competition is free to enter, however entrants must be:

- Living in Jersey and aged between 12 – 18 years old on the 10 November 2021

Privacy and consent

- All personal information, such as your name, contact details, email address and age, is collected solely for the purposes of administering this Competition and shall not be used for any other purpose without your consent.
- Your data will be securely stored in our system for the duration of the OHP, which is anticipated to be completed when the new hospital opens at the end of 2026. Ultimately, the entrant will own the work and permit OHP free use of it during the life of the Our Hospital design and construction project. If the entrant would like to use their work in other settings, a courtesy email is requested by the OHP team.
- If you are capturing anyone other than yourself in your still images/video entry, please ensure that you have their consent. You will need to list their details in your entry, and we may contact them to verify their consent.
- If you are under 18 years on the day you submit your entry, please ensure that you have read the conditions of entry with your Adult Sponsor (e.g. your parent, guardian or teacher) and understood them. You will need to provide your Adult Sponsor's details in your entry, and we may contact them to verify their sponsorship. Your Adult Sponsor will be notified if you are a winner.

General

- Adult supervision is permitted however entries must be the work of the individual entrant.
- Use of any copyrighted material is strictly prohibited. This includes multimedia, music and images that are not your own.
- Participants should use common sense and abide by all relevant local laws and regulations. More information can be found at jerseylaw.je

Prize giving

- The portion of the prize, which is to benefit a local not-for-profit/charitable organisation of the winner's choosing, will be directly donated by ROK FCC JV, the design and delivery partner of the Our Hospital Project.
- The IQ Store gift-card will be collectible by the winner from the OHP office on Don Street and further information on this will be supplied to the winner.
