

**Terms and conditions**  
**of animal encounters and live meet and greets in workshops**

1. All workshops are offered on a first come first served basis.
2. Any *Close Animal Encounter* last 30 minutes and are based on solely meeting some of the education livestock found at the park.
3. Live creatures are used and children must follow all necessary guidelines and rules set out by Paultons Park staff.
4. Handling is not included in any of the live animal sessions. Children may be allowed to stroke and pet animals at the Education staffs discretion.
5. Children will be advised on how to stroke live animals by the Education team.



6. All children must wash hands or use antibacterial gel before and after any contact with animals. This will be provided by the Education team.
7. A maximum of 35 children can take part in any live animal session.
8. Where the location of the session is held is at the parks discretion and may be subject to change at any point.
9. Animals used in each session are at the parks discretion and may be subject to change.
10. Strict handling guidelines are adhered to and animal welfare is our top priority. Therefore, the choice of live animals used in sessions is not guaranteed and alternatives may be used without prior notice.
11. You will be given a specific timeslot for your workshop. If you are late or miss it you will be charged.
