All resources will come in a pre-prepared teacher's pack which will be emailed to the class teacher. Resources will be cross-curricular and could, for example, include:

- Maths: costings, shape, measurements, data-handling
- Literacy: Persuasive writing, leaflets, information texts
- Geography: Map work
- Science: Forces
- D&T: Designing and building model fairground rides
- Art: Designing logos
- History: Timelines

As a project designed for the start of term (although could be used at any time) this project may also develop the following skills and attributes:

- Teamwork
- Interpersonal skills
- Independent working
- Confidence
- Time keeping
- 'Getting to know your classmates'



Practical information:

- A free 'masterclass' workshop is included in this topic when a visit is booked
- The masterclass will look at ride choice; ideas for a theme, target audience AND marketing
- All topic resources will be sent via email **INCLUDING** at the Park research ideas
