- ✓ Individually responsible for ensuring security procedures are adhered to and that there is controlled access to the Cash Room
- ✓ Reporting any discrepancies to the appropriate Departmental Management Teams
- ✓ Assisting with any required audits of Cash Room and its systems
- ✓ Completing external "spot check" audits of tills/cash taking areas on regular basis, as required
- ✓ Undertake any Administration tasks as required by the Central Services Manager or Administration Management Team to assist with the smooth running of the Administration Centre

- ✓ This is a seasonal position where you'll be predominantly working weekends and some weekdays, including school and bank holidays. Hours will be rostered in advance and vary dependent on the time of year. Flexibility is required in order to meet peak and off peak demands of the business.
