

Questions from Open Evening – 22/05/18

No	Question	Answer
1	Can pushchairs be brought onto school site?	Yes, but pushchairs will not be allowed in buildings.
2	I bring other people's children to school; can I still do that?	Yes, but we ask that you drop off older children to classes first.
3	Will children still be able to travel to school on bikes and will there be bike racks provided?	Yes, but bike racks will not be available so there will be nowhere to safely store bikes and scooters, which would need to be taken home by parents.
4	Could we consider Juniors at say, 8.30am, and infants at 8.45am, all come into the hall and then go to their classrooms?	This has been considered but wouldn't work. The movement around school when all children were going to class would be difficult.
5	How do parents access Breakfast / After School Club? Breakfast Club to use hall in mornings for easy drop-off and easy transition to classrooms?	There will still be access to Breakfast Club. Details to be provided at a later date by P.O.S.S.
6	E-block demolition – to put insects in garden for kids to see etc.	To be considered after completion. We could involve the Derbyshire Wildlife Trust as we have in the past.
7	Fencing a bit low behind Lunch Room block! Can this be renewed by school and made higher for safety of the children?	This will be considered by the Board of Governors.
8	Will there be any more shade on the playground when the work is completed?	This will be evaluated after completion of the new build when we can see if the new shape of the main building offers more shade.
9	Will we be able to access the school via Alton Road entrance during the school day?	No, all parents, visitors and deliveries will only have access to school through the main entrance.

There will be another opportunity to discuss the plans with governors at the PSA Summer Fair on Saturday 30th June (11am-2pm) where there will be a governor stand.
