Annual Reports to Parents

You can collect these on **Thursday 12th/ Friday 13th July** before and after school. If you cannot get into school on the relevant days to collect reports/data sheets these will only be sent with your child **with written permission**. Having read the report if there is anything you wish to discuss then please make an appointment with the class teacher.

September Reminders:

1. **Uniform** is now all on line (we still have book bags in the school office). Year 2 children are in navy sweatshirts/cardigans as they become juniors. We don't allow backpacks to be brought to school as a general bag, we cannot physically accommodate them. PE kits are already in that type of bag on the coat hook. Please make sure that the everyday bag is **flat** like the school book bag (alternatively a carrier bag) so will go flat against the wall when on the coat hook.

2. **New Build** if new build timescales go to plan, then on return in September, phase 2 is that our playground will be fenced off and the builders will have taken over the car park and playground. We let you know some time ago about our staggered start and end to the school day next year: Y5 /6 8.45, Y3 /4 8.50, Y1 /2 8.55 and Reception 9.00. At the end of the day: Reception 3.15, Y1 /2 3.20, Y3 /4 3.25 and Y5 /6 3.30. Families may be dropped off in turn as soon as the eldest is dropped off but siblings will not be brought outside until the relevant home time. If phase 1 has taken longer than thought (putting sports courts on the field for us to use as a junior playground) then we will still start with a staggered start and end.

Midday Supervisors Posts

New build will bring many challenges along the way and our first is managing our children within and around the site at lunchtime, ensuring that they all get some time outdoors. To this end we need 5 additional midday supervisors for next year. If you can do some days each week but not all 5 this isn't a problem.
