


# Year 1/2 Parents' meeting 12.9.18

## Reading

Please try to read regularly with your child and spend some time talking about the book. Aim to read at least 4 times a week. The reading targets in the front of the book will help you to devise appropriate questions.

Targets: You are welcome to tick off the targets in your child's reading record if they are evidenced at home.

Targets are changed every half term.



## Behaviour system

Gold star badges are awarded on a Monday having been earned

the previous week.

The children earn a gold star if they stay off red and amber for the week. If your child does not get a gold star the reasons why will have been explained to him/her.

## Homework

Homework will be set on a Wednesday for the whole week. We ask that homework books be handed in on the following Tuesday.

Homework will consist of reading, spelling and numeracy work.

The children need to make a good attempt at each aspect of homework (including reading at least 4 times) in order for them to get their homework signed off.

Parents will be contacted if no attempt is made to do the homework so please get in touch if circumstances prevent this.

## Uniform

Please ensure that the children have a coat in school this term as cold weather will not stop us having break times outside.

All items of clothing should be clearly named including, coats, jumpers, hats and PE kit.

Please make sure this is your child's name not that of an older sibling.

Remember that for P.E. the children need a pair of socks and a pair of shorts as well as jogging bottoms and a jumper.



## Topic work



This half term our topic is Pirates. We will look at how pirates travel and where they go with a focus on forces and geography. At the end of the topic we hope to hold a Pirate Party where the children can dress up as pirates for the day.
