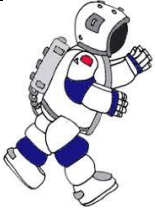


Year 5/6 Parents' meeting 8.1.19

Reading / Spelling

Reading is vital to success at key stage 2

Please read regularly with your child (3 - 4 times per week)
Please don't forget to tick off targets in your child's reading record if evidenced at home. Use the question prompts to help ask appropriate questions for your child's year group. If reading is not signed in reading records homework marks will not be awarded.
The children will be bringing home the new 'age expected' spellings for their year group. We have additional resources in school to support your child with their spellings. Please let us know if you would like any of these sending home.

Times tables

It is an expectation that all children know up to 12x12 by the end of year 4. We have recently purchased times tables rock stars for children to use at home. This is a great website to improve children's fluency with their times tables as well as their division facts. Children all have a personal login.



SATs

In the summer term of 2019, children in Year 6 will take their SATs . **The dates are 13th- 16th May 2019.** Children will sit tests in: Reading, Maths, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. Children's writing levels will be assessed internally but may be moderated externally.
