

Rules we need to follow to keep everyone safe:

- Keep apart when coming in and out of the school gate and when moving around the school.
- When queuing up leave a gap between you and the person in front. There are lines marked for lunch so you know where to stand.
- You must queue for dinner up the corridor, through IT and into the hall. You come back from dinner down the usual corridor through the toilet area and straight out keeping away from others.
- In the hall when sitting down for dinner you will be told where to sit by the midday supervisors. You will not be sat next to anyone else.
- You must wait for your group to leave the hall and the midday supervisor for your class to come with you.
- You must wash your hands carefully when you come into school, after using the toilet, before and after playtime and lunchtime, after any sport/games activity and before you go home.
- If you know you are going to cough or sneeze, catch this in a tissue and bin the tissue then wash your hands straight away.
- If you know you are going to cough or sneeze try not to face someone else.
- Try not to touch your mouth, nose or eyes during the day.
- You are in a small group in class, this is your group. You must not join another group or use any equipment that any other groups is using. If there are 2 groups outside in 2 separate areas and something comes onto your side e.g. a ball, you must not touch this. If one of your balls rolls onto the other side, only an adult may get this back.
- In the classroom you are not to share any equipment. You will have your own set (Y1 to Y6).
- In the classroom if you need to leave your seat e.g. for the toilet or to bin a tissue, put your hand up and wait for the adult to speak to you (Y1 to Y6)
- Tell an adult if you are not feeling well.
- Your group will have its own toilet/toilets to use throughout the day. Use this/these at all times, even at lunchtime. Always go to the toilet before going to lunch.
- All other usual school rules still apply.

First Aid

- You will be asked to clean up a graze, the adult will pass you a wipe and then a bag to put this in.
- You might be asked to put a plaster on, the adult will pass you one.
- If you try and can't do this the adult will help but they will first have to put some special clothes on before they can help. They might look like this:

Toilet Accidents

- You will be asked to take wet clothes off and put them in a bag to take home. The adult will give you some clean clothes to put on.
- If you try and can't do this, or if you have 'poo' everywhere and can't clean yourself the adult will help but they will first have to put some special clothes on before they can help. They might look like this:
