Nominators please note to give your nominees the best chance of winning, write your supporting evidence addressing the five points below. Each nomination will be marked against these 5 points:

- Level of achievement
- Strength of competition
- Length of participation
- Personal achievement
- Sportsmanship

1) Community Club of the Year

For clubs that have made a significant impact or achievement over the past 12 months. This could be by achieving Club Accreditation (clubs must be club mark accredited), having made a significant contribution to the community or delivered a successful project that has increased participation and / or volunteering.

Criteria:

 Clubs must either have a home venue, pitch, clubhouse, facility or regular use of facility within Daventry District

2) Team of the Year

For teams that have achieved success over the past 12 months – in the past has been won by teams who are National Champions or reached National Finals. Organisations should demonstrate the successes of a particular team and put that success into context. This applies to professional and amateur / community status teams.

Criteria:

- Teams must either have a home venue, pitch, clubhouse, facility or regular use of facility within Daventry District
- Teams should be based with a club that is based in Daventry District and be affiliated to the Local / National Governing Body of Sport

3) Coach of the Year

For individuals who have made a significant impact through their coaching over the past 12 months. This can include coaching teams / individuals to relative success or a coach that has made a significant contribution to the community, club or organisation. This is open to professional, paid and unpaid coaches.

Criteria

- Nominees should be delivering activity within Daventry District
- Nominees must have a recognised National Governing Body Coaching Certificate.
- Coaching can either be in a volunteer or professional capacity

4) Volunteer of the Year

For individuals who have made a significant contribution to a community or club project / programme and / or a significant contribution to volunteering at sporting events over the **past 12 months**. This could be someone who is **new to volunteering** or an existing volunteer.

Criteria

- Nominees volunteering must be within Daventry district
- Individuals will be assessed on their volunteering contribution over the past 12 months.

5) Primary School of the Year

This award recognises a Primary school that has made a significant impact with its delivery and commitment to PE and School Sport, have used programme such as the School Games and Change 4 Life to embed PE & sport within the school ethos, have made effective use of the PE and School Sport Premium funding and have enabled students to access community based opportunities.

Criteria

School should be based in the district

6) Secondary School of the Year

This award recognises a Secondary school that has made a significant impact with its delivery and commitment to PE and School Sport, having used programme such as the School Games, Change 4 Life and Young leadership to embed PE & Sport within the school ethos, have taken a lead within an area / Partnership and have enabled students to access community based opportunities.

Criteria

School should be based in the district

7) Young Leader of the Year

For individuals who have been actively volunteering in the community or club environment over the past 12 months and have shown leadership qualities and potential for the future.

Criteria

- Nominees should be delivering activity within Daventry District
- Nominees with CSLA, Leadership or NGB coaching qualification would be at an advantage
- Nominees must be under 18 years of age on the 1st September 2018.

8) Young Sportswoman

For individuals who have had success at an elite level in the past 12 months – this can be regional, national or international success or representation. Young people who have also shown great sporting advocacy and leadership qualities (i.e. as a captain) can also be a contributing factor.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or go to school within Daventry District
- Nominees must be under 18 years of age on the 1st September 2018

9) Young Sportsman

For individuals who have had success at an elite level in the past 12 months – this can be regional, national or international success or representation. Young people who have also shown great sporting advocacy and leadership qualities (i.e. as a captain) can also be a contributing factor.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or go to school within Daventry District
- Nominees must be under 18 years of age on the 1st September 2018

10) Disabled Sports Person

For individuals who have had success at an elite level in the past 12 months – this can be county, regional, national or international success or representation. People who have also shown great sporting advocacy and leadership qualities (i.e. as a captain) can also be a contributing factor.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or are based within Daventry District
- Nominees must be registered disabled

11) Local Sportswoman

For individuals who have had success in the past 12 months – this can be national or international success or representation. People who have also shown great sporting advocacy and leadership qualities (i.e. as a captain) can also be a contributing factor.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or are based within Daventry District.
- Nominees must be over 18 on the 1st September 2018

12) Local Sportsman

For individuals who have had success at an elite level in the past 12 months – this can be regional, national or international success or representation. People who have also shown great sporting advocacy and leadership qualities (i.e. as a captain) can also be a contributing factor.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or are based within Daventry District.
- Nominees must be over 18 on the 1st September 2018

13) Lifetime Contribution to Sport

For individuals (or can be a group) who have made a significant contribution to the development of sport or range of sports in a community or club environment, and in some cases exceeding expectations of their paid / volunteer roles. This can be over any length of time period.

Criteria

- Nominees must live, represent a club or are based within Daventry District.
- Nominees contribution must be within Daventry District
