- **Post-leave** – attend following your return to work as a working parent.

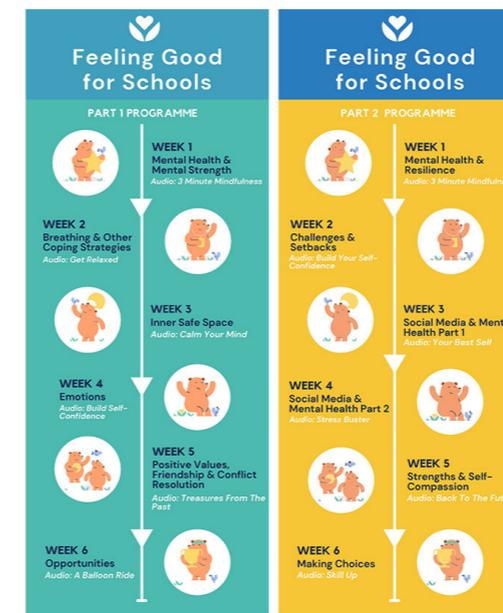

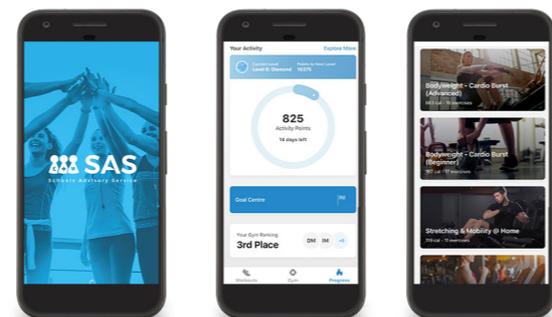
SAS GYM

Pupil Yoga services are designed to help pupils:

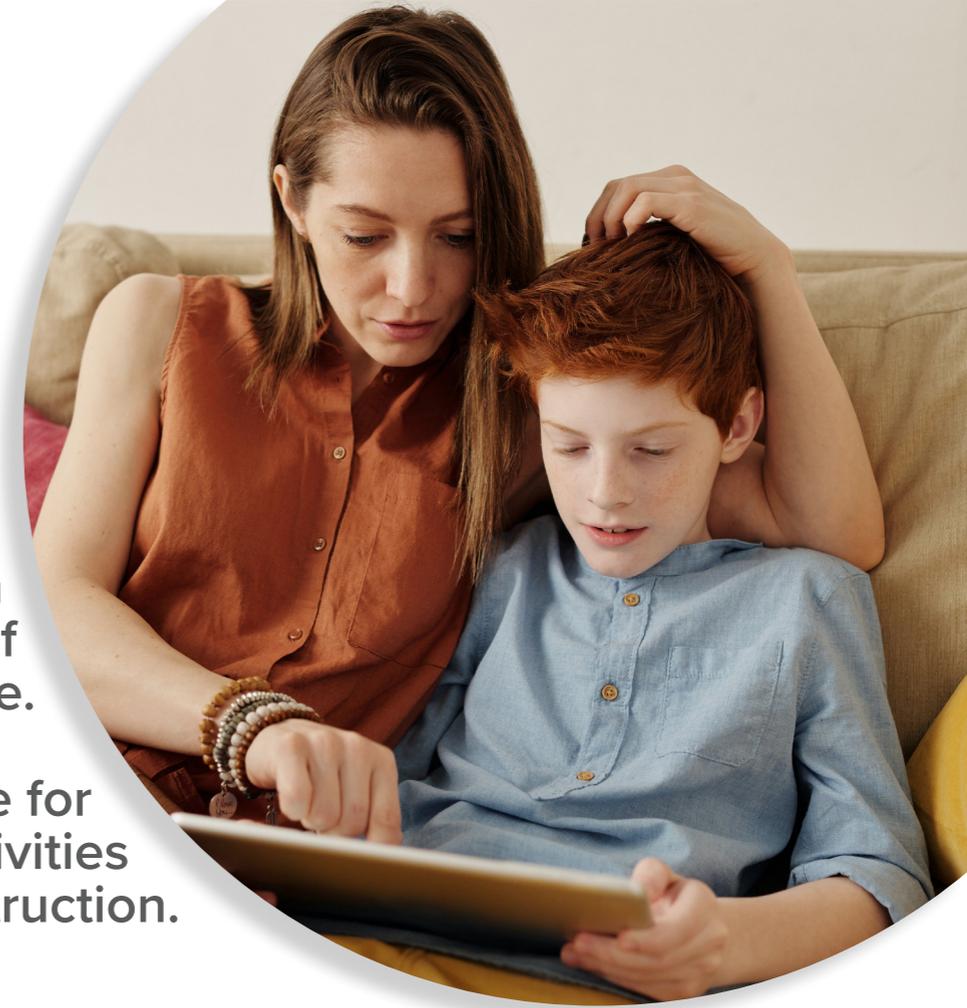
- Build Focus and Concentration

- Spread connection through growing acceptance & sense of community.



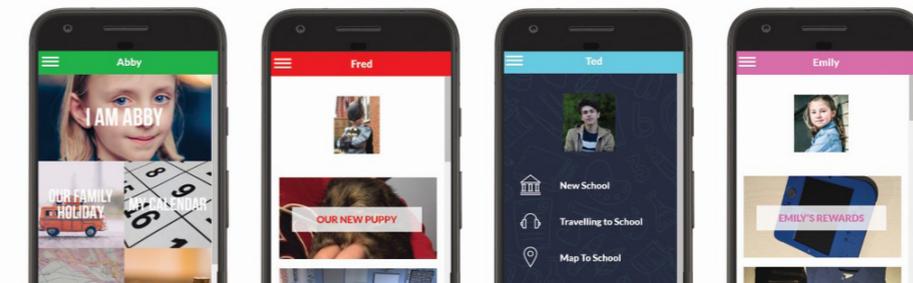
My SEND Pupil Support

Counselling

SAS offer confidential, individual therapy sessions* to staff which are delivered safely and appropriately and available whether you are still working in school or absent through illness.

The need for therapy does not need to be work related.

*The number of counselling sessions available is equal to the number of staff included i.e. 50 staff = 50 counselling sessions. Additional sessions can be purchased at £300 for initial assessment plus 5 sessions.
