

Junction improvements on Cullum Road / Parkway / Out Westgate / Westgate Street, Bury St Edmunds

These improvements will ease congestion through Bury St Edmunds and create a safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists

Works information

Locations: Westgate Street / A1302 Parkway and Cullum Road, Bury St Edmunds

The junction improvements will involve replacing the existing double mini roundabout with a single roundabout, the installation of a new footpath and pedestrian crossing and an upgrade to the street lighting and traffic signals.

The new footpath will provide additional space for cyclists to cross safely alongside pedestrians.

The existing puffin crossing (signalled) in Westgate Street will be converted to a toucan crossing.


Night time working

Start date: Tuesday 29 August 2017

Planned end date: Saturday 2 September 2017

Night time working times: 8pm – 5am

The day time working will be complete and the overnight works will commence to resurface and reline part of Parkway/ A143/ A1302 and Westgate Street, including the new roundabout. This work will take place overnight to limit disruption during the day.

Traffic management

Westgate Street will be closed between Guildhall Street and the Cullum Road roundabout for the duration of the improvement works. Temporary traffic signals will be in place along the A1302 Parkway and Cullum Road to support the closure, to ensure a safe working area and to manage traffic levels and speed.

Diversion route 1: Westgate Street, Crown Street, Honey Hill, Sparhawk Street, Southgate Street, A1302 and Cullum Road.

Diversion route 2 : – Cullum Road, A1302, Southgate Street, Manewater Lane and Westgate Street.

Please note: The times and dates of these improvement works may be subject to change due to unforeseen factors, such as bad weather, or the need to undertake some work at weekends to minimise significant traffic disruption and delay during the working week.

Information for residents and businesses

Pedestrian access to properties and businesses in the road closure area will be available throughout the improvement works. Staff on site will be able to answer any questions and help you safely get in or out of the area. However, access to your property may be temporarily unavailable for periods of 15-20 minutes, for example, if we are digging up the road or footpath outside your property or laying a new surface.

Businesses: We understand that businesses need to know that customers can still visit so, where appropriate, we will display signs saying "Businesses open as usual".

Parking: Before the start time of the works, all parked vehicles must be removed from the road.

Noise: We will use vehicles, heavy machinery and equipment that will create noise, but we will keep the noise down as much as possible.

Other services have been notified of these works including emergency services, local bus operators and St Edmundsbury Borough Council for bin collections.
