

BURY'S GOT TALENT 2019

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions relate to your application to participate in a talent search competition entitled "Bury's Got Talent".

All are eligible to apply to enter this competition except if you are a close relation to the Organizers of this event.

By making an application you acknowledge and agree to abide by the rules, regulations, terms and conditions for this competition as determined by the Organizers (the "Rules") and you acknowledge that the Rules may be changed (including without limitation verbally) at any time by the Organizers in its sole discretion. The Organizers decisions regarding all elements of the application process and the competition shall be final and binding.

A registration form can be download at www.theatreroyal.org/upcoming and searching for Bury's Got Talent, or collected in person from the Theatre Royal Box Office. Once completed, return by post to Jacqui Laidler, Theatre Royal Supporters Group, Orchard House, Elmswell Road, Great Ashfield, Bury St Edmunds, IP31 3HQ, or email it to burysgottalent@gmail.com.

Along with the Registration Form, competitors must submit an audition DVD, or send URL link of your audition video uploaded to YouTube (video can be unlisted but NOT public or private), to burysgottalent@gmail.com or a link from Dropbox to burysgottalent@gmail.com and a recent photograph of the applicant; which should be clearly marked with the applicants' name. Applications will not be returned unless you enclose a SAE. The closing date for registration and submission of your audition video and photograph is 31st July 2019.

The permitted performance times are as follows: Solo acts – maximum of three minutes Groups of two – maximum of three minutes Groups of three – maximum of three minutes Groups of four or more – maximum of five minutes

The Organizers do not accept any responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure or malfunction or any other problem with any online applications, telephone networks, line, system, server, provider or otherwise, (including postal services) which may result in applications not being received properly.

Any application received after the closing date will not be considered.

If you are under 18 years it is essential that you get the permission of your parents or legal guardian before applying, without this your application cannot be processed,



If you are under 18 years of age and you are invited to the Heats, you must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to the competition. Proof of age will be required at the Heats.

All personal details and/or information given in your applications either in the registration form or otherwise must be truthful, accurate and in no way misleading.

The organizers reserve the right to disqualify you if you have:

- Supplied untruthful, inaccurate or misleading personal details
- Have failed to abide by the rules
- Are in breach of the terms hereof.

The completion of the Registration Form does not guarantee that an applicant will participate in the heats.

Applicants will be selected to compete before a panel of judges at one of the three evening Heats to be held at Conservatoire East, West Suffolk College, on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd October 2019.

Successful applicants for the Heats will be notified by 1st September 2019. A £20.00 entry fee for the Heats will be applied to each act and must be received by the 10th September 2019 to confirm your place in the Heats. A cheque should be made payable to: Theatre Royal Supporters Group. If applicants invited to the heats wish to pay by electronic bank transfer details can be supplied by contacting burysgottalent@gmail.com

There will be a panel of judges for the Heats. They will select a number of acts to put through to the Final on the 20th October 2019. The Final will be judged by a panel of 3 or 4 judges who will select the winning act. Their decision is final.

In the event an animal act is invited to attend the Heats, you must ensure that you have obtained all necessary and proper immunizations for any animals involved in your act. You will provide to the Organizers all documentation and carry out any other preparation that may be reasonably necessary for the Organizers to determine whether the animal is safe to participate in the competition.

You must notify the Organizers, in advance, if you intend to:

- Perform physical and/or dangerous stunts, explaining the full nature of the stunt
- Use any form of equipment required as part of your act. You will be responsible
 for bringing such equipment (provided it is suitable for the Heat and Final
 location) and are responsible for ensuring that such equipment is safe and fit for
 purpose.
- Pyrotechnics are not permitted.

The Organizers reserve the right to cancel the competition should there not be enough entries.

The prize pot of £1000 will be divided as follows and presented on the night of the Final.

The winner of Bury's Got Talent 2019 will be presented with a cheque for £750 The second placed contestant will be presented with a cheque for £200 The third placed contestant will be presented with a cheque for £50
