introduction

Environmental control for Hydroponics.

Hydroponics is playing an increasingly important role in horticultural production; providing commercial & domestic growers with a wide variety of fresh produce including fruit, vegetables, cut flowers and other leading crops.

Air movement is an essential part of maintaining optimal growth conditions inside greenhouses, grow rooms or other protected crop structures. High quality airflow assists by modifying temperature, humidity and carbon dioxide levels at the leaf surface where the important plant process of photosynthesis and transpiration are occurring.

Correctly designed and installed systems can also reduce incidences of associated diseases such as mildew and Botrytis as well as bacterial infection.

Hydor product range is designed specifically for Hydroponic growers and stand out from the crowd in many areas including the design and choice of materials, their noise and performance characteristics and their product attributes. air movement

Good ventilation that continuously replenishes the air is critical for healthy plant growth.

Providing the correct amount of air movement across a leaf surface is essential for good production and yields, and can signify the difference between high rates of photosynthesis taking place or none at all. High-quality air flow also assists temperature control, carbon dioxide replenishment, lowers humidity and diminishes the incidence of specific diseases.

Even a small amount of air movement over the leaf will remove stale, humid air from the boundary layer that lies just above and just below the leaf surface. This boundary layer of air supplies the leaf with carbon dioxide and also holds much of the moisture transpired by the plant.

If there isn't any air movement, diffusion of water vapour out of the leaf and carbon dioxide into the leaf begins to slow, as the mixing of the boundary layer air into the rest of the environment is too slow.

One of the most effective methods for cooling greenhouses, grow rooms and other protected cropping structures is having adequate air flow supplied in from the outside and then extracted out again. The amount of ventilation necessary to sustain the ideal temperature range, will depend on factors such as the temperature of the incoming air and the heat load from lights in the growing area, as well as the quantity of air drawn in and removed again on a regular basis.



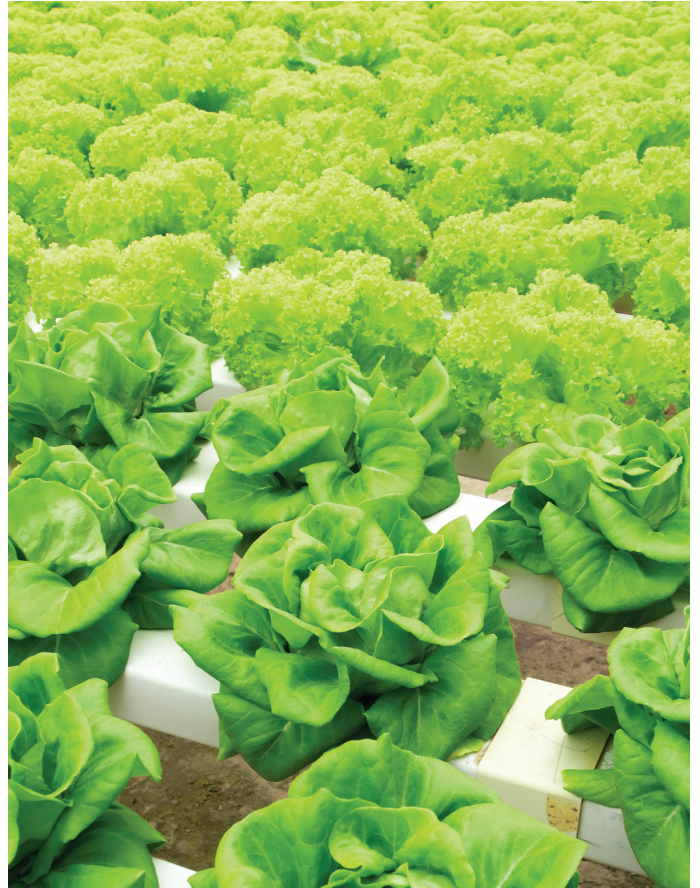
High humidity levels can become a major problem where plants with large leaf areas, in a warm but restricted growing environment, are continually transpiring and releasing water vapour into the air.

Ideal humidity levels for most plants are in the range of 70 - 80%, however the higher the humidity level, the greater the risk of certain plant diseases such as mildew and Botrytis as well as bacterial infection where moisture forms on the leaf surface.

At Hydor, our range of fans for growing applications are designed to not only extract the humid air, but also supply drier air to the growing area; essential for enhanced plant growth and disease prevention.

When humidity levels are high, condensation at night can become a major problem, by providing the perfect environment for many fungal spores and bacterial diseases to infect the plants. Air movement is an effective way to reduce humidity and prevent condensation- protecting the plants from disease outbreak.

Hydor's commitment to providing growers with correctly sized supply/extract fans, well positioned circulating fans and control systems, culminates in the very best conditions for growth, development and maximum yields.



fan selection

Fan Selection for greenhouses, grow rooms and other protected crop structures

Ventilation system

Selecting the correct fan for a growing area is important for plant growth and development as well as disease prevention. The most effective set up comprises of a low level intake with the extract fan(s) positioned at a higher level on the opposite side of the room. The cool, drier air sucked in from outside will flow up, through and over the crop and warmer, moist air which rises, will be extracted by the fan at the other end of the room. Wall or floor mounted circulation fans should be positioned to assist the extract fan and increase the airflow up and under plants, avoiding stale air pockets which may be prone to fungal or bacterial disease attack.

How much airflow?

If excess heat in a certain growing environment is a common problem, or there is a large volume of plants growing in a very restricted space, you will need more air flow per hour than for a larger growing area that doesn't suffer from excessive heat build up. Growers commonly underestimate just how much air exchange is required to remove excess heat or humidity, bring in fresh carbon dioxide and generally create fresh air movement over all of the plant surfaces.

Greenhouse crops in full sunlight with large, mature crops growing in warm, humid conditions will require 60 air changes per hour. During winter months, fans are required to remove warm moisture-laden air to reduce the humidity rather than reducing the temperature. The minimum winter airflow rate for controlling humidity and condensation should never be allowed to drop below 2 air changes per hour.

In smaller grow rooms, 12 to 15 air changes per hour would be acceptable. However, this would need to increase to 20 to 30 air changes per hour if a lot of extra heat due to lighting needed to be removed, or if carbon dioxide enrichment was not being used.

Fan types

Axial fan

Used to move large volumes of air against little resistance.

Centrifugal fan

Used to overcome the resistance caused by long duct runs, insect screens and filters.

Mixed flow fan

A combination of an axial and centrifugal fan suitable for relatively large air volumes and high resistances.

How to select a fan

Step 1:

Calculate the volume of the growing area by multiplying the length x width x height (a nominal 2.4m for greenhouses). This will give the volume of the growing room in m³.

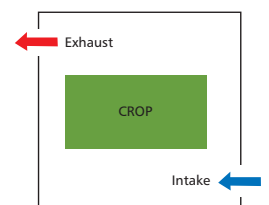
Step 2:

Decide on the number of air changes that are required to ventilate the growing room in warm conditions; this is the maximum airflow rate.

Step 3:

Multiply the volume of the growing room x the number of air changes per hour. This will give the required airflow rate in m³/hour. Fans are normally rated in terms of m³/hour or in m³/second. To convert from m³/hr to m³/s, divide by 3600.

This powerful fan produces air volumes up to 20m³/s. Constructed from galvanised steel with a specially designed stainless steel impeller, these fans are extremely hard wearing and robust in application. 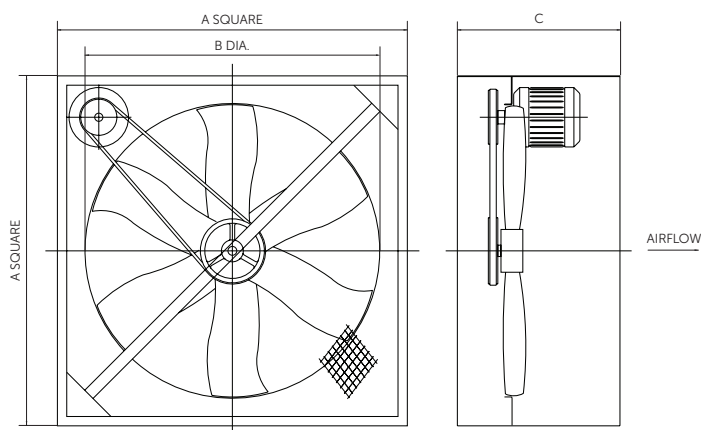
